STRATEGIES FOR SUSTAINABLE FUNDING: GRANT WRITING + MORE!

What is it?

A 6-week training program for a total of 30 hours (4-5 hours/week) of online trainings and live coaching calls from Jan. 18 - Feb 24, 2022 taught by Learn Grant Writing, an Alaskan company that teaches globally and has extensive experience in the North.



Who is it for?

This training is available for Indigenous-led science and knowledge programs focused on food security, land and water stewardship, environmental changes, and climate adaptation efforts. It is open to communities and Indigenous organizations based in Alaska and western Canada.

All participants will have access to the course materials for a full year and will receive a copy of the book "How to Write a Grant: Becoming a Grant-Writing Unicorn." Participants will graduate with a project planning toolkit, a draft funding strategy reviewed by a coach, and a folder of grant application templates. The program consists of both self-study instructional sessions and live group call training sessions.

Learn Grant Writing has customized this training for the "Northern Connections" project - an effort funded by the National Science Foundation to support and connect Indigenous-led science and knowledge programs in the North. Tuition for the 6-week training is \$1,000 USD. Full scholarships provided by Northern Connections will be made available for 20 individuals to attend the course for FREE.
